- 1. Harris County and Harris County Flood Control District employees be paid for all hours worked directly related to the response and recovery efforts for the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic for the period of October 10, 2020 through October 23, 2020.
- 2. Only work expected to be reimbursed through FEMA's Public Assistance Program or other sources should be considered under this Order. Departments should consult with Human Resources & Risk Management before paying employees for all hours worked to determine if it is expected to be reimbursed by FEMA or other sources.
- 3. Temporary Amendment to the Harris County Personnel Policies and Procedures be made as follows:
 - a. Section §9.0112 The 75-day benefit waiting period for new employees will be temporarily suspended until October 31, 2020. New regular position employees will be eligible for group health benefits the first day of the pay period following 7 days of continuous employment.
